General Rules

- The different events in 6th UThfest will be organized in accordance with Association of Indian Universities (AIU) Unifest rules wherever applicable.
- The theme of the 6th UThfest 2020 is 'INDIA OF MY VISION'. Participants are expected to incorporate the theme of 6th UThfest in various events.
- One student can participate in maximum three events in 6th UThfest of UTU.
- One institute/department can send maximum two entries/participation and minimum one entry/participation in every event of 6th UThfest **except *asterisk events** as found in above table.
- Only **bonafide, full time student**, who is enrolled for a degree or post graduate degree or diploma programme in constituent institute/department of Uka Tarsadia University, is eligible for participation.
- Participant must carry original Identity Cards during 6th UThfest.
- Every participating institute/department's students should be accompanied by a Team manager (Faculty member).
- Team managers have to verify all the documents of participants of their respective institutes/departments at the time of online registration.
- Participant has to follow time limits for all events wherever applicable.
- There would be no provision for on-spot registration for any event.
- Last date of entry for participation in 6th UThfest is 5th Feb 2020.
- Funfair comprising of food stalls and fun game stalls will be organized during 12-14 Feb 2020.
- A maximum of two stalls would be allotted per institute/department for Funfair.
- If the behavior of any participant is found contrary to the objectives of the festivals the **Uka Tarsadia University may** take suitable action against members concerned and an individual / team be debarred from participation in 6th UThfest.
- The Eve Teasing, influencing the adjudicators, indecent behavior inside the campus and venue is strictly prohibited. Those violating this clause shall be liable to disciplinary action which may be to the extent of debarring the concerned from participation in the 6th UThfest.

- A cultural Procession/ March past of participating teams shall be organized on inaugural day before the formal inaugural ceremony. **Participating Teams are required to bring their flags/ placards for this event.**
- In order to have creativity, the Team managers are requested to present new Cultural items and not to repeat the same, which they presented in the preceding year.
- Participating teams are informed that the use of fireworks/ arms is strictly prohibited. However, if it is unavoidable for cultural performance, their imitation may be used with the prior permission of the organizing committee at Uka Tarsadia University.
- The participants are requested to carefully study the rules and regulations for the various events, given on www.utu.ac.in.
- **The decision of the judges appointed for different events shall be final.** It is expected that their judgment will be respected. No protest shall be entertained on matters regarding judgment.
