Code of Conduct for Student

Students must uphold the dignity of AMTICS.

Students should set high academic goals and clearly define them from the beginning. Proper conduct, good manners, and respect are expected from each student, both individually and as a group.

A tradition of prayer recitation is held on campus at 8:25 AM. All students must be present at the

designated venue.

Students are expected to be polite, whether individually or in groups, and to show respect toward teachers and other staff members of the Institute and the University. Instructions given by teachers

and counselors should be followed diligently.

- Attendance is mandatory following the teaching schedule provided by the class counselors. Absences due to illness or unavoidable circumstances will be considered only with valid medical certificates signed by a medical officer and a leave application from parents, with a maximum allowance up to 25%
- Students must refrain from activities that could harm the academic environment, the teacher-student relationship, or the Institute's culture. Students should balance extracurricular activities with academics and avoid disrupting academic schedules. Those students, whose academic involvement at institute is subpar, will not have the opportunity to represent the institute at any stage or event.

7. Students must maintain a dignified appearance, wearing the Institute uniform, and identity card

- Students are required to adhere to timeline for end-semester examination form submission. Failure to comply will result in exclusion from the examination.
- Students must understand and adhere to the rules, regulations, and guidelines issued by the Institute Office, University Office, and Examination Section for smooth operations.
- 10. No student or group of student may form any organization, society, or event, or collect funds or data involving other students without prior written permission from the Institute.
- 11. Carrying or consuming intoxicating substances will result in cancellation of admission or expulsion from the college.
