On June 10, 2024, Uka Tarsadia University organized a comprehensive one-day Teacher's Training Program focused on Student Centric Teaching for the teachers of SETH RJJ School (Valsad-Navasari). The expert speaker of the program was Dr. Rozy Patel, Dean and Director of the Department of Humanities.
