4. Refreshments

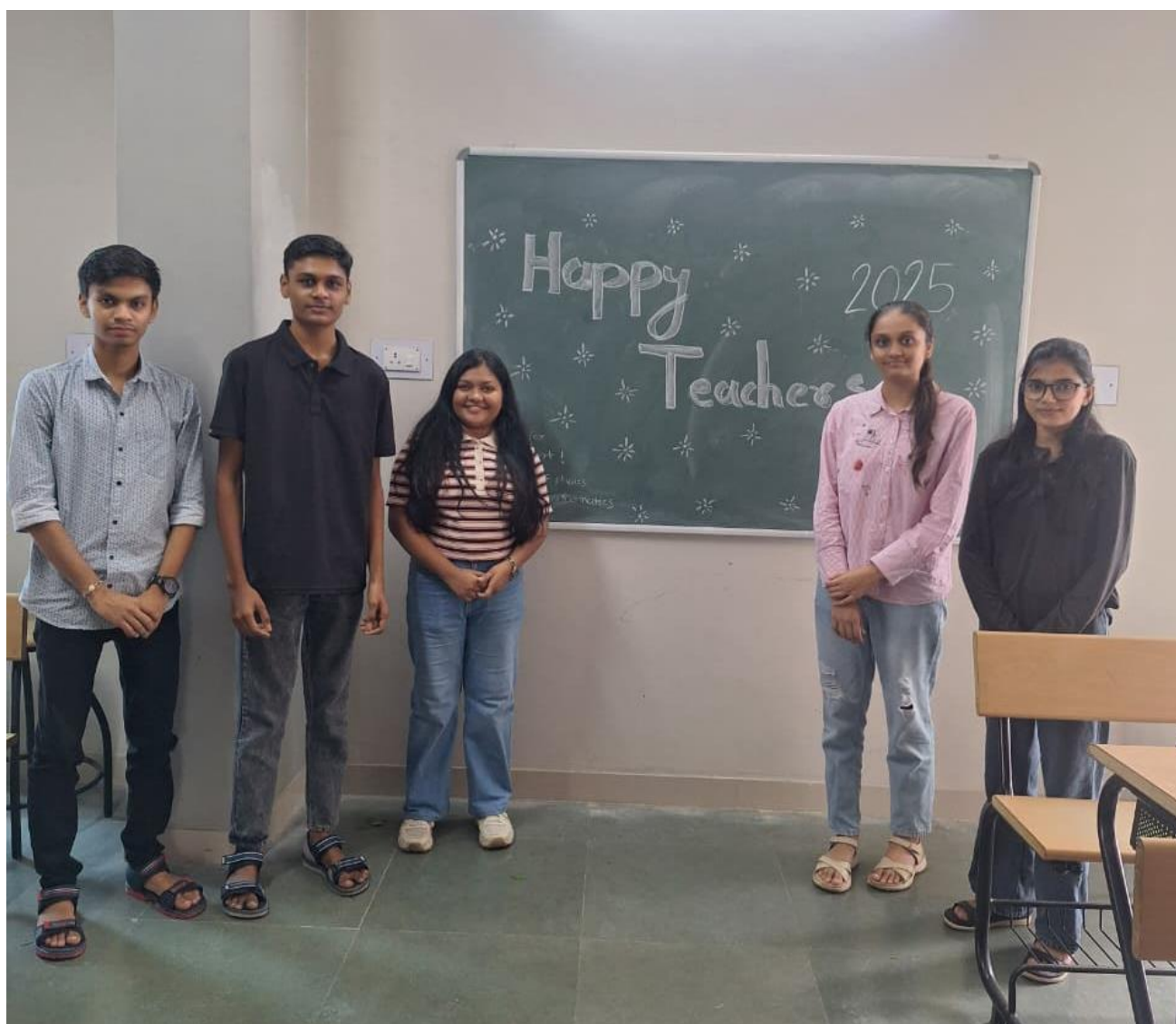
**Program Outcomes – Teachers' Day Celebration**
