

How to Prepare for Civil Services Examination

On 28/9/2013, students of Department of Commerce and Management attended an expert lecture on “How to Prepare for Civil Services Examination”. The resource person was Shri S. A. Patel, an IAS officer and also the joint Director of Sardar Patel Institute of Public Administration (SPIPA).

Mr. Patel talked with relevant statistics and informed the audience that due to lack of awareness about this profession among Gujarati students and parents there is a dearth of officers in Civil Services from Gujarat. Only consistent efforts are required. One should not give it up if disqualified in the first attempt. Further attempts should be made to become successful. Students should have high aims in life. Thus, he ignited the young minds and motivated them to try for the prestigious and glamorous profession of Civil Services.
