CATEGORIES FOR PRESENTATION

JUNIOR RESEARCHER BPT STUDENT, INTERNS, MPT STUDENTS

SENIOR RESEARCHER ACADEMICIAN AND CLINICIAN

The abstract should not exceed 250 words (excluding the title)

The sole subject of papers should be physiotherapy research The research topic should not have been previously presented at or published in a scientific journal

Subheadings that needs to be included in the abstract during online submission:

- Title of Abstract
- Authors (Full name, title, affiliation, city and state of presenter and all co-authors should be included)
- Name of the presenting author should be underlined
- A completed abstract with structured format should include;
- 1. Background and need of research
- 2. Methods
- 3. Result
- 4. Conclusion and Clinical Implications
- 5. Key-words
- 6. Funding acknowledgement
- 7. Ethical approval (wherever required)

Rules and regulations for paper presentation

- It is mandatory to register for Conference 2023
- A code will be assigned to the submitter of the abstract for paper presentation at the time of acceptance, and code will be your identity for any official scientific communication.
- TIME FOR PAPER PRESENTATIONS is 8+2 minutes (8 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for question answer session).
- Paper presentation should be in MS Power Point format (limit to 10-15 slides).
- First slide should be with title and registration number and final presentation should not reveal identity of any author or the Institute / Hospital.
- Succeeding slides must have heading and maximum of 6 lines per slide. Slide number should be mentioned
- Can include subtitles such as need for the study/review, methodology, results, discussion, conclusion etc.
- References need not be included. If required, it will be asked during the question hour
- Reviewers of the abstract have all rights to accept / reject the paper for presentation during the conference and presenters will be intimated well in advance.
- Judge's decision shall be final and abiding
- Certificate will be issued to the presenting author only.
- The presenting author is required to ensure that all coauthors are aware of the content of the abstract before submission.
- Each author can submit and present only a maximum of 2 abstracts.
- Send in your entries to srcp.conference@utu.ac.in and make sure you send your category of presentation on/before March 5.
