WORKSHOP CONTENT:

The expert talk was held at ShrimadRajchandra College of Physiotherapy (SRCP) on 8th and 16th August, 2022. Dr.Pranjal Contractor (PT), Assistant Professor at SRCP, was instructor for this talk and she had delivered lecture on Neuroanatomy of thalamus and its functions by using chalk and board method to third year BPT students. In the expert talk, 53 students had participated. Dr.Pranjal Contractor had covered anatomy of thalamus, its relation with other structures of brain, importance of thalamic nuclei, working mechanism and its clinical presentation. Students were able to identify the structures and also were able to give answers about the function of various thalamic nuclei appropriately.
